

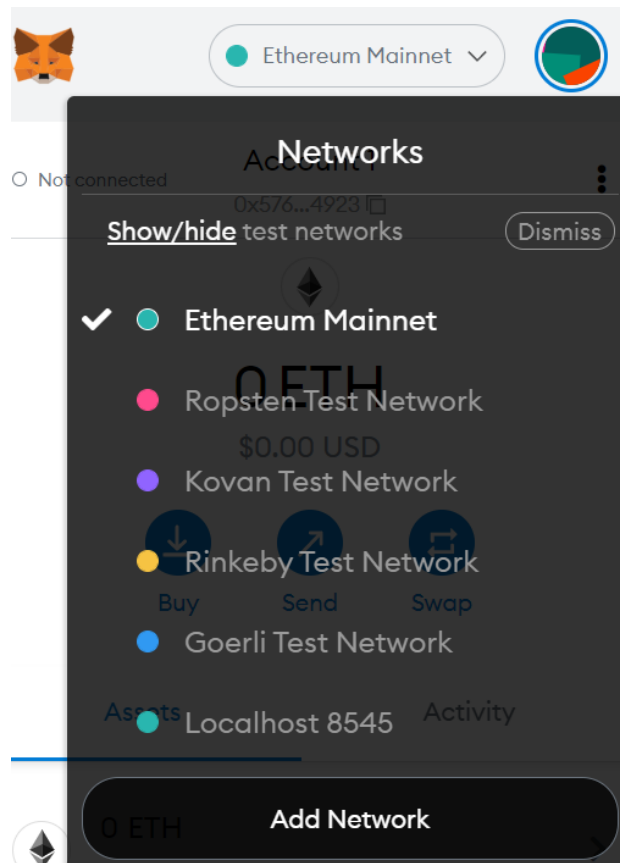
How to set up Avalanche on Metamask

A non-custodial wallet is a way to store crypto separately from a centralized trading platform. Metamask is one of the most used and versatile crypto wallets.

Metamask was made primarily as an Ethereum wallet but can be configured for many other blockchains. In the case of the Avalanche network, it can be configured to receive and manage the Avalanche c-chain and access the DeFi realm made on this ecosystem.

First we need to [install](#) Metamask on our browser!

To set up Avalanche, once we are logged in to the wallet, we will click on the Network dropdown and click on “Add a new network”.



We will enter the following settings into the respective fields:

- **Network Name:** Avalanche Network
- **New RPC URL:** <https://api.avax.network/ext/bc/C/rpc>

- **ChainID:** 43114
- **Symbol:** AVAX
- **Explorer:** <https://snowtrace.io/>
